The JLUS Policy Committee Role

The JLUS Policy Committee is comprised of representatives from each of the participating parishes Councils and/or School Boards, the Regional Planning Commission, the La. State Senator's Office, the U.S. Senator's Office, the Louisiana Economic Development Office, and local business owners.

The JLUS Policy Committee guides the development of the study. These responsibilities will include:

- Approval of the study design and final work program
- Review and approval of policy recommendations put forth by the JLUS Technical Committee
- Participation in public involvement efforts
- Approval of draft and final written reports
- Monitoring implementation of the adopted policies

The Policy Committee will likely meet only for major presentations of information and findings, review of policy issues and final endorsement of the completed report and its recommendations.
