Council Member Cognevich moved to Agenda Item 11i, "Discussion and update on Ordinance No. 19-92, adopted August 8, 2019, authorizing the President to remove the Empire Shipyard sheet pile wall; and Resolution No. 19-158, adopted May 23, 2019, authorizing the President to institute a public notification system to notify the public of closures and openings of the flood gates in the Parish". Council Member Blink explained that legislation was done nearly three years ago and no action has been taken on either piece of legislation. In regard to Ord No. 19-92, Council Member Blink said the wall was heavily damaged in Katrina so it hasn't worked since then and it is an eyesore. Since there has been no action by the Administration, he called some scrap companies to remove the sheet wall and hopefully we will have some action on this matter. In regard to Res No. 19-92, it was enacted because people are often stuck inside or outside the flood gates, especially just before hurricanes which causes a lot of confusion about when these things are going to close. Council Member Blink has spoken to John Helmers who believes there is a piece of hardware available which would aid in a very easy notifications system on the Parish website. Interested parties could check the website and there would be a map of Parish floodgates with indication if the gates are open or closed. Council Member Blink further stated that it would be very helpful to fisherman to have a tidal gage on the Parish website. Especially in Empire floodgates where the floodgates sometimes close up to a 100 days a year.

Council Member Cognevich then asked the public if anyone wanted to discuss any matter on the agenda and there was no response by anyone in attendance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE PLAQUEMINES PARISH COUNCIL THAT the Secretary of this Council is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify and release this Resolution and that Parish employees and officials are authorized to carry out the purposes of this Resolution, both without further reading and approval by the Plaquemines Parish Council.

There being no further business to come before this Council, on motion Council Member Barthelemy, seconded by Council Member LaFrance, and on roll call all members present voting "YES" except Council Members Black, Arbourgh, Rousselle and Newberry who were "ABSENT", the meeting adjourned at 3:24 p.m.
