**STATE OF EMERGENCY - SALTWATER WEDGE INTRUSION
PLAQUEMINES PARISH, LA**

WHEREAS, as a result of the low river situation of the Mississippi River, a saltwater wedge is intruding upriver, which due to a lack of forecasted rainfall is expected to continue moving upriver and have significant adverse effects on portions of the potable water supply on both banks of the Mississippi River in Plaquemines Parish, LA from which raw water is drawn, treated, and delivered to all residents and businesses throughout Plaquemines Parish; and,

WHEREAS, as a result of this saltwater wedge intrusion, I desire to order the initiation of the Parish's emergency operations plan and use the necessary emergency powers authorized by state law to respond to this threat to the lives and property of the citizens and businesses of Plaquemines Parish, Plaquemines Parish Government, and the Plaquemines Parish Port Harbor and Terminal District on both banks of the Mississippi River; and,

WHEREAS, there is a requirement and a necessity to provide for the essential and necessary potable water supply operations of Parish Government to meet the needs of the Parish and its citizens as it pertains to the water supply and the quality thereof;


NOW THEREFORE: I, Kirk M. Lepine, in my capacity as duly elected President of the Plaquemines Parish Government, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Charter for Local Self-Government for Plaquemines Parish, LA and by the Louisiana Disaster Act of 1993, LSA – R.S. 29:727(D), do hereby find and declare that a state of emergency exists in the entirety of Plaquemines Parish as a result of the developing threat of a saltwater wedge intrusion in the Mississippi River, which will adversely affect the potable water supply for Plaquemines Parish and has the potential to cause serious adverse consequences to the lives, homes, property and commercial and industrial businesses located therein from Wednesday, September 28, 2022 for thirty (30) days, which may be extended pursuant to law, if necessary, and that all Emergency Preparedness Plans and the Parish All Hazard Emergency Operations Plan be activated to take any and all actions necessary to address the saltwater wedge intrusion in the Mississippi River and its effects in order to reduce or eliminate the aforementioned consequences to our citizens.
